Bullying Incident Required Reporting

According to the Ohio Revised Code:

Harassment, intimidation, or bullying" means either of the following:

- (a) Any intentional written, verbal, electronic, or physical act that a student has exhibited toward another particular student <u>more than once</u> and the behavior both:
 - (i) Causes mental or physical harm to the other student;
 - (ii) Is sufficiently severe, persistent, or pervasive that it creates an intimidating, threatening, or abusive educational environment for the other student.
- (b) Violence within a dating relationship.

Further, the ORC outlines a requirement that the district administration semiannually provide the president of the district board a written summary of all reported incidents and post the summary on its website, if the district has a website.

During the first semester of the 2022-2023 school year, there were no reports of alleged bullying in the Canfield Local School District.
