School Districts throughout Ohio are participating in an effort to identify, locate, and evaluate all children with disabilities from birth to age 21 who may be in need of special education programs or services or accommodations under Section 504 of the American's with Disability Act (ADA).

For children birth to three, a disability means an established condition known to result in delay or a documented developmental delay for children ages 3-21.

A disability means that a student has been identified as having one or more of the following conditions: multiple disabilities, orthopedic impairment, other health impairment, speech and language impairment, special learning disability, traumatic brain injury, visual impairment, hearing impairment, emotional disturbance, cognitive disability, autism, deafness, and deaf-blindness.

Canfield Local Schools offers evaluation and education for all children with suspected disabilities from age 3 through 21 attending both public and non-public schools within our district.
